## Financial Aid Dependent Housing Agreement 2023-2024

Culver-Stockton College is dedicated to the development of each student's ability to function and communicate with other people and to foster a sense of responsibility and respect for others. The situations that arise in a group living environment provide a very real laboratory for students to grow in their knowledge of themselves.

According to the college policy, as stated in the Culver-Stockton College Cat Tracker:

"Because of the college's belief in the value of residential life, residence hall living is required of all full-time students. Exceptions to this policy are students who are married or living with their parents or a legal guardian. In addition, students age 21 or older by September 1 of the academic year in question that do not receive institutional financial aid may choose to live off-campus."

This means that a student who receives institutional funding must either live on campus, or commute from their parents' home address, which should be within 50 miles of driving distance to the college. If a student does not adhere to the housing policy, institutional funding will be removed.

Dependent students who change their housing status from "on-campus" to "commuting from parent's home address" will receive a reduction of up to \$5,000 in financial assistance per academic year as their funding was based upon accruing room/board charges.
