

**CULVER-STOCKTON COLLEGE
FINE ARTS FINANCIAL AID AGREEMENT
2023-2024**

1. This agreement is made between Culver-Stockton College, referred to as the college, and " _____ " referred to as the student.

That in exchange for the college providing fine arts financial aid to the student, and the student agreeing to comply with the following requirements, it is mutually agreed as follows:

The college shall provide the fine arts financial aid indicated in your financial aid package and made a part of this agreement for participation in the fine art(s) program(s).

2. It is understood that the award for fine arts financial aid made to the student shall be for the academic year listed above, subject further to the following requirements:
- a. Fine arts financial aid refers to all grants or scholarships awarded by the college that require participation in one or more of the college's fine arts programs to be received.
 - b. Fine arts financial aid in additional academic years will be re-evaluated on a year-by-year basis by the faculty of the fine arts programs for which the aid is received.
 - c. If the student voluntarily chooses not to participate in the fine arts program for which financial aid is awarded, all fine arts financial aid is canceled immediately, and any fine arts financial aid already received for the current semester is subject to repayment.
 - d. If a student is permanently dismissed (cut from the program for disciplinary, lack of participation or any other reason, such as failure to adhere to C-SC Substance Abuse Policy) from the fine arts program for which financial aid is awarded, the aid received for the current semester will be refunded to the college on a prorated basis.
 - e. Nursing students are not eligible for fine art financial assistance once they reach Jr/Sr status in the nursing program.
 - f. All students have the right to appeal or reject any aid awarded by the college and to appeal any award decisions to the Admissions and Financial Aid Committee. Appeal of the financial aid award must be submitted in writing to the Director of Financial Aid. The Admissions and Financial Aid Committee will inform the student of their decision concerning the appeal within a reasonable time following its receipt.
3. For the student to qualify for the fine arts financial aid awarded, this agreement must be signed by the student if the student is 18 years of age or older, or by the student and a parent or duly appointed guardian if the student is under 18 years of age.
