

CULVER-STOCKTON COLLEGE
ATHLETIC FINANCIAL AID AGREEMENT
2026-2027

Note: This document will only be accepted if **all sections are fully completed by the athlete.**

1. This agreement is made between Culver-Stockton College, referred to as the college, and _____ " referred to as the student.

In exchange for the College providing athletic financial aid to the student, and in consideration of the students' agreement to comply with the requirements outlined below, the parties mutually agree to the following terms:

The college shall provide the athletic financial aid indicated in your financial aid package and made a part of this agreement for the following sport(s) _____.

2. It is understood that the athletic financial aid awarded to the student shall apply to the academic year listed above and is subject to the following requirements:
- a. Athletic financial aid refers to all grants awarded by the college that require participation in one of the college's sponsored intercollegiate athletic programs to be received.
 - b. Athletic financial aid in additional academic years will be re-evaluated on a year-by-year basis by the coaching staff of the sport for which the athletic-related aid is received.
 - c. If the student voluntarily chooses not to participate in the sport for which athletic financial aid is awarded, all athletic financial aid is canceled immediately, and any athletic financial aid already received for the current semester is subject to repayment.
 - d. If a student is permanently dismissed (cut from team for disciplinary or other reasons, such as failure to adhere to C-SC Substance Abuse Policy) from further participation in the sport for which athletic financial aid is awarded, the athletic aid received for the current semester will be refunded to the college on a prorated basis.
 - e. If the student is placed on disciplinary probation by the college for a period of time less than the remainder of the current academic semester, the student is automatically barred from athletic participation until the disciplinary probation period is ended, and the athletic financial aid shall continue.
 - f. If the student is placed on disciplinary probation by the college and the student is dismissed by the coach from participation in the sport for which the athletic financial aid is awarded, then the athletic financial aid received for the current semester will be refunded on a prorated basis.
 - g. If the student is placed on academic probation by the college, the athletic financial aid shall continue for the remainder of the current academic year, subject, however, to the student continuing to work in some capacity assigned by the coach or coaches of the sport for which the athletic financial aid is awarded.
 - h. If the student is injured and declared by the team and/or an approved physician to be unable to participate in the sport for which athletic financial aid is awarded, the athletic financial aid shall continue for the remainder of the current academic year and subsequent years subject, however, to the student continuing to work in some capacity assigned by the coach or coaches of the sport for which athletic financial aid is awarded.
 - i. It is understood that the student is not eligible for athletic financial aid until after the completion of athletic eligibility.
 - j. It is understood that nursing, radiology, respiratory care, and medical sonography students are not eligible for athletic financial aid once they reach junior or senior status in their respective programs.
 - k. All students have the right to appeal or reject any aid awarded by the college and to appeal any award decisions to the Admissions and Financial Aid Committee. Appeal of the financial aid award must be submitted in writing to the Director of Financial Aid. The Admissions and Financial Aid Committee will inform the student of their decision concerning the appeal within a reasonable time following its receipt.
3. In order for the student to qualify for the athletic financial aid awarded, this agreement must be signed by the student if the student is 18 years of age or older, or by the student and a parent or duly appointed guardian if the student is under 18 years of age.
