## Financial Aid Dependent Housing Agreement 2026-2027

Culver-Stockton College is committed to fostering each student's personal development, particularly in their ability to interact and communicate effectively with others. The group living environment offers a valuable opportunity—serving as a real-world setting in which students can deepen their understanding of themselves while developing a sense of responsibility and respect for those around them.

According to college policy, as stated in the Culver-Stockton College Cat Tracker:

"Because of the college's belief in the value of residential life, residence hall living is required of all full-time students. Exceptions to this policy are students who are living with their parents or considered Independent by FAFSA guidelines."

Students receiving institutional funding are required to either live on campus or commute from their parent's permanent residence, which must be located within a 50-mile driving distance from the college.

Failure to comply with this housing policy will result in the removal of institutional financial aid.

Dependent students who change their housing status from "on-campus" to "commuting from a parent's home address" will receive a reduction of up to \$5,000 in institutional financial aid per academic year. This adjustment reflects the removal of room and board charges, which were originally factored into the students' financial aid package.
