1.	This agreement is made between Culver-Stockton College, referred to as the college, and "" referred to as the student.
	That in exchange for the college providing fine arts financial aid to the student, and the student agreeing to comply with the following requirements, it is mutually agreed as follows:
	The College will provide the fine arts financial aid outlined in your financial aid package, which is considered part of this agreement for your participation in the fine arts program(s).
2.	It is understood that the fine arts financial aid award granted to the student applies to the academic year listed above and is subject to the following requirements: a. Fine arts financial aid refers to all grants or scholarships awarded by the college that require participation in one or more of the college's fine arts programs to be received. b. Fine arts financial aid for future academic years will be re-evaluated annually by the faculty of the applicable fine arts program(s). c. If the student voluntarily chooses not to participate in the fine arts program for which financial aid is awarded, all fine arts financial aid is canceled immediately, and any fine arts financial aid already received for the current semester is subject to repayment. d. If a student is permanently dismissed (cut from the program for disciplinary, lack of participation or any other reason, such as failure to adhere to C-SC Substance Abuse Policy) from the fine arts program for which financial aid is awarded, the aid received for the current semester will be refunded to the college on a prorated basis. e. It is understood that nursing, radiology, respiratory care, and medical sonography students are not eligible for fine art financial aid once they reach junior or senior status in their respective programs. f. All students have the right to appeal or reject any aid awarded by the college and to appeal any award decisions to the Admissions and Financial Aid Committee. Appeal of the financial aid award must be submitted in writing to the Director of Financial Aid. The Admissions and Financial Aid Committee will inform the student of their decision concerning the appeal within a reasonable time frame after the appeal has been received.
3.	For the student to qualify for the fine arts financial aid awarded, this agreement must be signed by the student if the student is 18 years of age or older, or by the student and a parent or duly appointed guardian if the student is under 18 years of age.
