MEASURE	DESCRIPTION AND HOW IT WAS CALCULATED
Graduation Rate	The graduation rates for all majors above are determined by comparing the number of students in the respective major who graduate from Culver-Stockton College within two years to the total number of junior level students who have declared a major in that respective field minus students who have

	transferred out. For all majors, two years of data are used due to the small number of graduates for those majors.
Masters Graduation Rate	The graduation rates for all master's concentrations above are determined by comparing the number of students (within their respective concentrations) who graduate from Culver-Stockton College within two years from entering the program minus transfer outs. For all concentrations two years of data are used due to the small number of graduates.
